## ICSES2010 Newsletter – October 2010

Dear Colleagues & Friends , We are delighted that so many of you were able to attend the ICSES2010 Congress and would now like to present to you the statistics and the highlights from the Congress.

The final official statistics show that:-

- 1026 abstracts were submitted - 189 (18%) were accepted for podium presentation plus 295 (29%) as ePosters; 4 ePoster Videos were also accepted.
- 47 abstracts were submitted for the ICSET Congress – 24 (51%) were accepted for podium presentation.
- 1,548 Registrants attended our Congress plus 202 Registered Accompanying persons

### The Kessel Lecture: Stephen R Burkhart, San Antonio, Texas

#### “Moving Forwards the Frontiers of Arthroscopic Shoulder Surgery”

Stephen’s Lecture gave us all an insight into the future for Shoulder Surgery with a considerable amount of background research into how modern thinking and particularly the use of biological treatments are likely to radically change the way that surgeons carry out their surgical procedures in the future. He deserved the standing ovation accorded to him at the end of his presentation.



### The Codman Lecture: Herbert Resch, Salzburg, Austria

#### “Proximal Humeral Fractures: Current Controversies”

Herbert delivered his life experience of treating proximal humeral fractures and educated us all on what was possible and how it should be done. He acknowledged the difficulty of classifying these fractures and how efforts had been made to make classification simpler. His lecture provided expert guidance to all surgeons about the importance of getting the 1st operation right and his tips & tricks for doing this for our own operations in the future. His lecture was a masterpiece.

### The ICSET Keynote Lecture: Jeremy Lewis, London, England

#### “Subacromial Impingement Syndrome: A Musculoskeletal Condition or a Clinical Illusion?”

Jeremy argued that subacromial impingement syndrome is unlikely to be caused by the acromion and should be called subacromial pain syndrome. His lecture focussed on the shift away from mechanical, extrinsic models of rotator cuff irritation towards an intrinsic tendinopathy model. He illustrated the lack of robust evidence for subacromial decompression surgery and the cost effectiveness of conservative treatment in comparison.
